	Will water actually move into or out of an egg demonstrating osmosis?
	HYPOTHESIS:
	A. The eggs will shrink/swell in distilled water because water will move down the concentration gradient.
	B. The eggs will shrink/swell in sugar solution because water will move down the concentration gradient.
