In science you will use as a **NOTE TAKING OUTLINE** for deep reading of the textbook material... you will take a few "laps" through the section to THIEV your way to understanding (we do NOT just list)

## How to take THIEVES notes in science

**T** Use the Title as a title for your notes

**H** Turn Headings into research questions &/or use headings as MAIN IDEAS to organize your notes

**I** Always read an Introduction as an overview (APK)

**E** *IF you are just skimming: read every 1st sentence*

IF you are taking notes write the important facts/  
examples/evidence from EACH PARAGRAPH

**V** Vocabulary defined in glossary

Visuals give information too... ADD TO NOTES!

**E** End of section questions check understanding  
(sometimes assigned with notes; sometimes for SWYK)

**S** Summary of learning: maybe a SWYK, maybe a CEAL

**THIEVES** help you 'STEAL' information from the text

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
