Step 2: Fold the paper the hamburger way again, one time. Your paper will be 5 1/2" x

Step 3: From the folded edge of the paper, cut down the middle along the fold line to



Step 4: Open the paper flat. Fold it one time the hot dog way.



Step 5: Hold each side with one hand and push towards the center until your fingers meet. The center of the paper will push or creating 4 flaps.



Step 6: Press down, so pages line up into the booklet shape. The finished booklet is 6 pages (not including front and back


